Dear Friends,

For a number of years, we have recognized that a major barrier to our ability to meet the future needs of our target populations was our overcrowded facility. On February 2, Special Transit closed on 6.7 acres of land, and two weeks later, we broke ground for construction of a new facility for the 21st century. Under the leadership of our exceptional volunteer steering committee, we completed a successful capital campaign by year-end. Surpassing our fundraising goal for the \$11.5 million project allowed us to incorporate additional sustainable building features into the facility to enhance cost-effective and environmentally friendly operations. Eleven months after our groundbreaking ceremony, construction was completed, giving us a building that is both beautiful and functional, and a giant step forward for the organization.

2010 was a year of capacity building, with a focus on planning for the future. In addition to completing the new facility, we consolidated service growth plans, financial sustainability models and various feasibility studies into one consolidated strategic plan. A "transformation" plan was developed to build on the lessons learned and successes of the capital campaign and to develop a more strategic fundraising and communications effort.

After a downturn in 2009 reflecting the depressed economy, ridership rebounded in 2010 with a seven percent increase in the number of trips provided. We expanded travel training offerings and rural transportation in the mountain communities and further developed our collaborative efforts to serve individuals experiencing homelessness and frail elders requiring companion-assisted medical transportation.

2010 was a momentous year for Special Transit! Managing a full plate of regular activities while completing a capital campaign and major construction project was at times exhausting, but ultimately fulfilling, as we set the stage for the next decades of Special Transit's service to older adults, people with disabilities, low income individuals and others with special mobility needs.

Accomplishments

Awards

- Boulder County Aging Services Division presented Special Transit with the 2010 Create Our Future Maximizing Independence Award. The award recognized Special Transit for its current building project designed to meet the transportation and mobility needs of the growing populations of older adults for decades to come.
- The Beverly Foundation of Albuquerque, New Mexico, awarded Special Transit a STAR Trustee Commendation Award for meeting the transit needs of a growing population of older adults by utilizing best business practices in the planning and development of the new building.
- The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) awarded Special Transit a 2010 FTA Administrator's Award for Outstanding Public Service for developing several innovative and effective programs to address critical mobility needs in the rural communities served by Special Transit.

Paratransit Program

- 124,309 one-way trips were provided, the most in the history of the organization.
- 2,139 unduplicated individuals were served.
- Trips increased by 7% throughout Special Transit's service area.
- Service to the Longmont community increased by 3%: 32,174 trips were provided.
- 11,212 trips were provided for individuals who are homeless in order to access safe shelter at the Boulder Shelter for the Homeless and at local churches.
- 30,948 trips were provided for medical or therapy purposes, 25% of the total service provided.
- 16,655 trips were provided to ensure access to food and nutrition programs, 13% of the total service provided.
- Older adults and people with disabilities in Boulder County received 105,962 trips, a 10% increase over 2009, and 1,833 residents were served.
- The average cost per paratransit trip was \$28.89.

- The volunteer driver medical transportation collaboration with American Red Cross provided 4,515 trips to residents of Longmont and Boulder. The average cost per trip was \$9.04.
- The Medical Mobility volunteer driver collaboration with CareConnect (formerly R.S.V.P.) provided 4,036 trips. The volunteer driver provides round trip transportation and stays with the rider through the health care appointment or procedure. The average cost per trip was \$22.26.
- 943 trips were reimbursed in the Friends and Family program at an average cost of \$4.97 per trip so that friends and family members could provide trips that could not be provided by Special Transit.
- 571,317 miles were traveled and 55,232 services hours were provided in support of our mission to promote independence and self-sufficiency.
- The program outcome measurement evaluation showed that 99% of our riders agreed or strongly agreed that Special Transit helps them to live a more independent and self-sufficient life.

The Easy Rider Travel Training Program

- 44 unduplicated individuals successfully completed the one-on-one mobility assessment and travel training program. Successful trainees used public transit for an average of 15 trips per month. Ninety-two percent agreed or strongly agreed that they felt more independent, and 83% agreed that they had more confidence in their ability to get to where they need to go as a result of the travel training.
- The Seniors on the Move, an abbreviated travel training program conducted in a group setting, served 48 unduplicated individuals through six classes. Seventy-six percent of those who completed the full program reported that they felt confident about their ability to travel independently on public transit.
- 30 community presentations were conducted on disability awareness and community transportation options; 445 attendees participated.
- The travel training program expanded into Denver through a contract with the Regional Transportation District (RTD).
- Six Train-the-Trainer seminars were conducted with 31 participants.

Mobility Specialist and Individual Travel Planning

- Acting as a travel navigator, the mobility specialist provides information and referral on a wide range of travel options and develops individual travel plans.
- The mobility specialist contacted 805 out of 1,045 newly registered Special Transit clients.
 - 580 had individual travel plans (ITP) developed.
 - Year-end evaluations indicated that more than 38% were complying with their ITP.
 - 187 individuals receiving ITPs did not become Special Transit riders or trainees.

17,296 trips were taken on public transit by individuals who had successfully completed the travel training program or complied with their ITP.



Safety

- The safety of our passengers, drivers and the public continues to be Special Transit's highest priority.
- Special Transit's drivers in the four divisions drove over 3.2 million miles, were involved in 23 preventable accidents and completed the year averaging 0.7 accidents per 100,000 miles driven.
 - 114 drivers were recognized with the Safe Driver of the Year Award for driving a minimum of 1,000 hours without any preventable accidents or safety infractions.
 - 34 drivers were recognized for five or more consecutive years of safe driving.

Significant Organizational Achievements

- A total of 2,359 unduplicated individuals were served in all transportation and mobility programs.
- A total of 144,605 trips were provided or enabled in all programs.
- Special Transit finished raising the \$11.5 million needed to complete the new facility for the 21st century.
- Construction on the new facility began in January and ended in December.

Special Transit's definition of an accident is any time a vehicle comes in contact with anything other than the tires touching the ground resulting in property damage or injuries of any amount.



Social Enterprise Earned Income Contracts

Social enterprise in the nonprofit sector may be defined as “improving the effectiveness and sustainability of the organization by employing earned income contracts to achieve social objectives.”

As a nonprofit organization, Special Transit ensures that all profits from earned income contracts are reinvested to enhance our mission services, to nurture the well-being of our organization, to reinforce our commitment to the communities we serve and to make our organization’s vision a reality.

In addition to important revenue, these contract services promote a balanced all-mode transportation network that provides transportation choices for people with mobility impairments, as well as youth, older adults and low-income individuals.

The HOP

The HOP is the heart of Boulder’s Community Transit Network. The HOP is a high frequency circulator shuttle connecting the primary retail, social and educational centers in the city of Boulder, including the University of Colorado. The HOP continued summer service to Chautauqua Park for evening performances of the Colorado Music Festival as well as other park events.

The HOP expanded free service for individuals experiencing homelessness so that they could access warming centers and night shelter in local churches during the winter sheltering season.



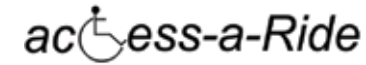

access-a-Ride is a complementary paratransit program mandated by the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and is provided throughout RTD’s fixed-route service area. As the regional public transit provider, RTD is legally responsible to fund and ensure that this service is available to eligible individuals. Riders on **access-a-Ride** must be certified as having a disability that prevents them from using the fixed-route system. In 2010, Special Transit, one of four **access-a-Ride** providers, traveled 1,874,674 miles and provided 90,328 trips.

All **access-a-Ride** drivers were recertified in the Passenger Assistance Program, which provides advanced training in customer service techniques appropriate for people living with a wide range of disabilities.



call-n-Ride is a hybrid demand-responsive service established to serve residents living in specific communities where fixed routes are generally not cost effective. Drivers take ride requests directly from a passenger and arrange their own driving schedules. Designed to connect people to the RTD **park-n-Rides** during peak hours, the service is open to anyone living or working within the defined geographic area.

Special Transit’s **call-n-Ride** program provided 127,824 trips and traveled 444,370 miles in eight communities including Longmont, Broomfield, Superior, Interlocken/Westmoor, Louisville, Brighton, South Thornton, and North Thornton. The pilot project continued in Longmont to coordinate **call-n-Ride** and Special Transit’s paratransit vehicles in order to improve vehicle utilization and increase options and service availability to more Longmont residents. Paperless mobile data terminals were installed in all **call-n-Ride** vehicles in the eight communities served by Special Transit.



1:00 p.m. June M., age 58, has been riding with Special Transit for 20 years. Today, she’s on her way to Walmart for a bit of shopping. 2010 Financial Highlights

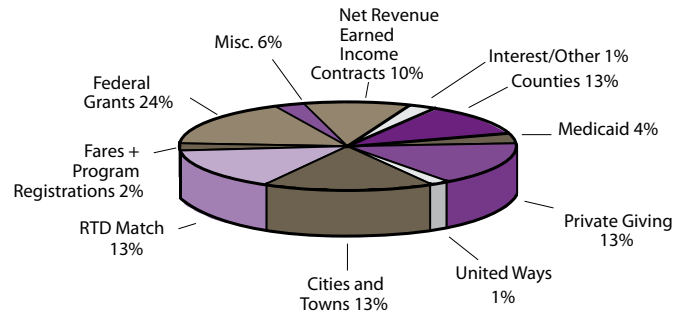
Special Transit purchased 6.7 acres of land for its new facility and began construction in early 2010. Significant funds were withdrawn from the facilities reserve account for construction in progress expenses related to the new headquarters for Special Transit including land purchase, facility design, legal and permit fees, project management and actual construction. The increase in assets is due to the acquisition of land and facility improvements. The significant increase in revenue is dominated by funds raised and committed to the building project.

Special Transit completed **The Ride of Your Life** Capital Campaign to raise dollars from philanthropic and other sources to fund the land acquisition and construction of the new facility. The increased costs of fundraising include those associated with the capital campaign efforts.

Special Transit holds three endowments – two restricted endowments managed by The Community Foundation Serving Boulder County and the Longmont Community Foundation– and an internally managed quasi endowment. The board of directors has set an initial goal of \$1 million dollars in principal accumulation before utilization of any moneys from the quasi endowment. This endowment can be invaded upon the affirmative vote of 80% of the entire membership of the board and only utilized to avert bankruptcy or to ensure the continuation of the fundamental mission of Special Transit that is threatened by the occurrence of an unanticipated catastrophic event.

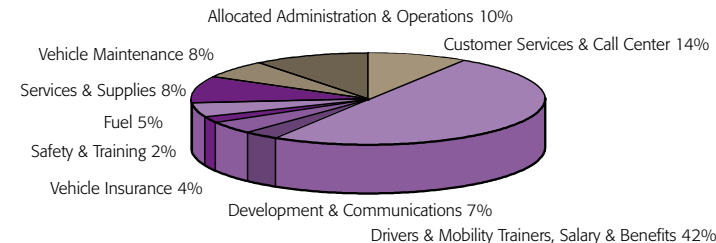
